## **RETROFIT 2050 DOCTORAL RESEARCH WORKSHOP**

## ON SUSTAINABLE URBAN RETROFIT

**Date**: Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> October 2013

Venue: Arup, 8 Fitzroy Street, London, W1T 4BQ

The focus for this interdisciplinary doctoral research workshop is to provide an opportunity for PhD students working on retrofit related issues within the six Retrofit 2050 project team universities to share theoretical and empirical insights on sustainable urban retrofit research.

Abstracts for papers to be presented at this workshop are invited from a variety of disciplinary perspectives: e.g. papers addressing the challenges of retrofitting the built environment from technical, managerial or socio-technical perspectives will all be considered. We will also be inviting senior academics from the Retrofit 2050 project team to engage in the discussion session after the presentations and also to provide relevant feed back to the doctorial students.

The format will be for approximately 15-20 researchers from the six Retrofit 2050 project team universities at various stages of their PhD studies to present a summary of their work for about 10 minutes each, with discussions afterwards. The programme will start with a lunch at 12:30 and presentations will run through from 1pm to 6pm. There will be a buffet tea at the end of the programme.
